






Honored as outstanding athletes at the Fall Sports Banquet were Lane Lohr, Most Outstanding Lineman; Scott Brothers, Boys Cross Country; Roger Neumeyer, Most Outstanding Lineman, Tammy Blackman, Girls Cross Country; John Paul Webber, Most Outstanding Back; and Lynette Nitsch, Girls Tennis.



Junior quarterback John Paul Web-ber was named Missouri 4-A Player of the Week and all State Honorable Mention. When the season ended, J.P. had compiled some impressive statistics for the record book, passing for 1,547 yards and averaging over 150 yards per game. J.P. threw 16 touchdown passes and ran for 4 more. J.P. was also named All Conference, All District and KFVS-TV Player of the Week.



Senior wide receiver Lane Lohr was named as a unanimous choice to the Missouri 4-A All State Football Team and was also named Missouri 4-A Player of the Week. Lane had 40 receptions during the season for a total of 1,033 yards, including 11 touchdown passes. His outstanding performance set a new school record for receptions. Lane was also named All Conference, All District and KFVS-TV Player of the Week.



Senior offensive tackle Roger Neumeyer was named to the Missouri 4-A All State Football Team for his consistent and aggressive play. Roger was also named All-Conference and All District both his junior and senior years.

The Jackson wrestlers under the leadership of Head Coach Bruce Thomas and Assistants Bob Sink and Steve Wachter had a highly successful season. The varsity closed out the regular season undefeated in dual matches with a perfect 11-0 mark, defeating the SEMO Conference Champion Sikeston Bulldogs in the last regular match of the season.

During the season the varsity wrestlers placed fourth in the Fox Invitational Tournament, first in the Parkway Quad, fourth in the Tiger Wrestling 42 / Wrestling





school tournament.





Despite heavy graduation losses, Jackson got off to a strong start by winning four of the first five games. In the second half of the season, facing the hardest part of the schedule, Jackson saw their playoff hopes vanish with an overtime loss to Dexter, the first overtime game in JHS history, and a one touchdown loss to Charleston. The outstanding performance of J. P. Webber and Lane Lohr was recognized when they were named Missouri 4-A and KFVS Players of the Week. Webber was the leading passer in Missouri 4-A schools and Lohr the leading receiver in 4-A schools for the 1982 football season.




