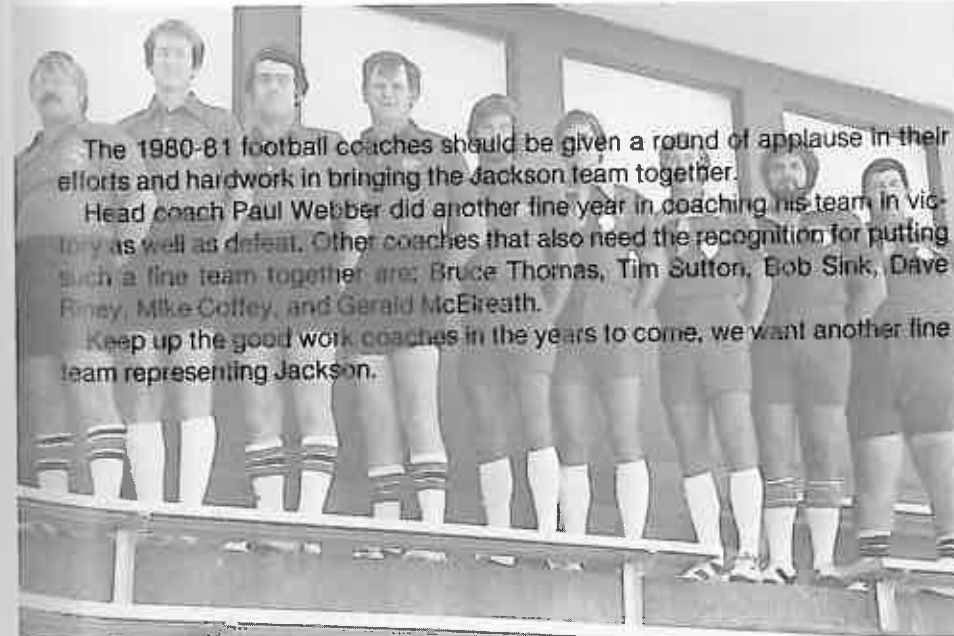


The 1980-81 football team started the season off with great motivation and a big win over DeSoto, 33-7.

The "Fighting Indians" had their ups and downs, but nothing could stop them in giving their all.

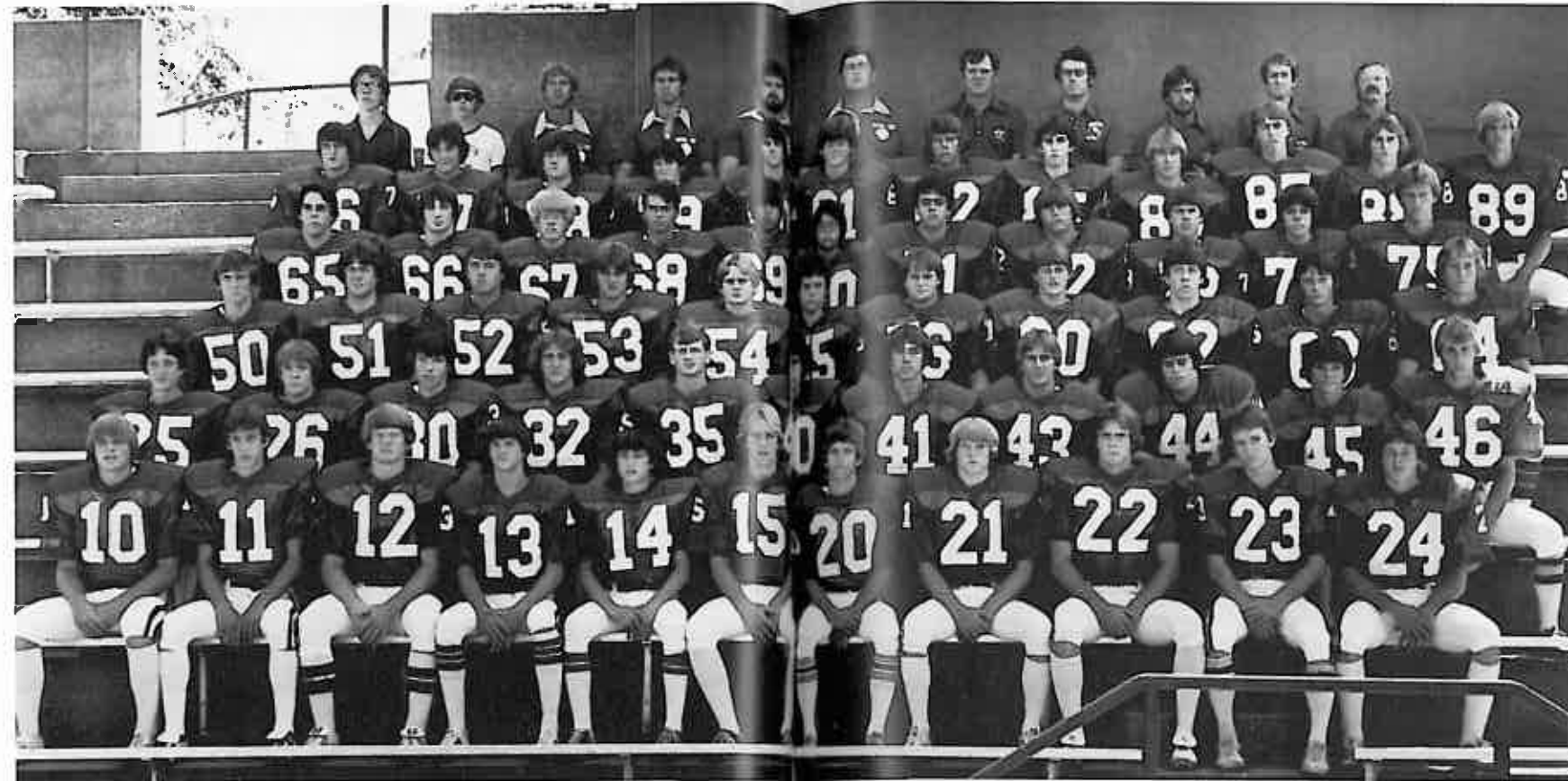


The 1980-81 football coaches should be given a round of applause in their efforts and hardwork in bringing the Jackson team together.

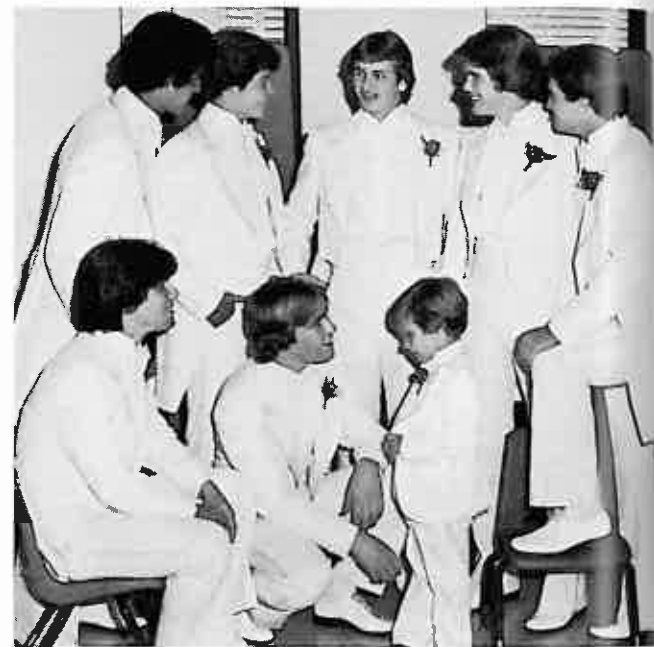
JHS "Snow Dance"
